## STARBUCKS PLANNED FOR ST. JOHN'S PAVILION

SPRINGFIELD, IL – As St. John's prepares for the opening of the new Surgery Center, a new look to the Pavilion's coffee shop is also in the works. Starbucks and St. John's have formed a partnership that will allow the space currently occupied by Dunkin Donuts to convert into a fully licensed Starbucks store.

"As we prepare to open our Surgery Center, we're also going to bring in a new franchise coffee shop. Starbucks will replace Dunkin Donuts and complete the new look and feel of the Pavilion," said Dave Olejniczak, FACHE, Chief Operating Officer of St. John's Hospital.

While the conversion is completed, the St. John's coffee shop space will serve Starbucks products through a Signature We Proudly Serve Starbucks Espresso, Blended and Coffee Program.

The coffee shop will provide Starbucks coffee roast spectrum, iced and hot espresso based beverages, three coffee and two crème based Frappuccino® blended beverages and Tazo hot and iced teas.

Grab-and-go food items, provided by St. John's Cafeteria, will also be available in the interim.

"We're looking forward to our partnership with Starbucks and the ability to offer a new branded alternative to our patients, visitors and those passing through the medical district," Olejniczak said. "We want to continue to meet the needs of those looking for grab-and-go food and beverages during their stay at St. John's."

The change to We Proudly Serve Starbucks is scheduled to happen in mid-May, and the fully licensed store should open in the next few months after the conversion is complete.
